

SIMPLIFIED PRENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

PARTIES:

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties contemplate legal marriage under the laws of the United States; AND WHEREAS, the Parties desire to establish their respective rights and responsibilities regarding each other's income and property and the income and property that may be acquired, either separately or together, during the marriage; AND WHEREAS, the Parties intend this Agreement to be legally binding and enforceable.

DEFINITIONS:

Separate Property:

Property owned by either Party before marriage, and any property acquired by gift, inheritance, or personal injury recovery during the marriage, which shall remain the separate property of that Party.

Marital Property:

Property acquired by either or both Parties during the marriage other than Separate Property, which shall be considered marital property subject to division upon dissolution.

Debts:

Any liabilities or obligations incurred by either Party before or during the marriage.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Separate Property Remains Separate

Each Party shall retain sole ownership, control, and enjoyment of his or her Separate Property, including all income and proceeds therefrom.

2. Marital Property

All property acquired jointly during the marriage shall be considered Marital Property and shall be divided equitably upon divorce, dissolution, or death.

3. Debts

Each Party shall be responsible for their own debts incurred prior to the marriage. Debts incurred jointly during the marriage shall be the joint responsibility of the Parties.

4. Spousal Support

Neither Party shall be obligated to pay spousal support or maintenance to the other Party upon dissolution of the marriage, except as otherwise agreed in writing.

5. Waiver of Rights

Each Party waives any right to claim an interest in the Separate Property of the other Party except as expressly provided herein.

6. Full Disclosure

The Parties declare that they have made a full and fair disclosure of their financial circumstances to each other.

7. Voluntary Execution

Each Party acknowledges that they are entering into this Agreement voluntarily, free of duress, coercion, or undue influence.

8. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the state in which the Parties reside.

9. Enforcement

If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

10. Amendment or Revocation

This Agreement may be amended or revoked only by a written instrument signed by both Parties.

11. Binding Effect

This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns.

12. Independent Legal Advice

The Parties acknowledge having had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice regarding this Agreement.
