

TRIAL SEPARATION AGREEMENT

PARTIES:

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties are currently married and desire to live separately for a period of time in order to evaluate their relationship; and WHEREAS, the Parties intend that this Agreement shall govern their rights and obligations during the trial separation period.

AGREEMENT TERMS:

1. Separation Period

The Parties agree to live separately and apart from each other during a trial separation period as mutually agreed. Neither Party shall interfere with the other's right to privacy and freedom during this period.

2. Residence and Personal Property

Each Party shall have the right to reside at the address designated above or any other mutually agreed-upon location. Personal property shall remain with the Party currently in possession unless otherwise agreed in writing.

3. Financial Support

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one instrument.
